Grammar Comic Book Assignment

Your task is to write a comic book that demonstrates a variety of grammatical concepts. You and a partner will write a story on a topic of your choice that includes each of the following grammar rules below. The best projects are those that are <u>creative and authentic</u>, neat and organized, and include sentences that meet the following grammar criteria:

- 1. Parts of Speech
 - a. Nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions and conjunctions
- 2. Sentence Parts
 - a. Simple subjects and simple predicates; complete subjects and predicates; compound subjects and verbs
- 3. Gerunds and Participles
- 4. Phrases
 - a. Prepositional and appositive phrases
- 5. Complete Sentences
 - a. Run-on sentences and sentence fragments
 - b. Using semi-colons
- 6. Subject and Verb Agreement
- 7. Pronoun-Antecedent Agreement
- 8. Restrictive and nonrestrictive phrases
- 9. Adjective and Adverb Clauses
- 10. Capitalization
 - a. Proper nouns

Students must also be aware of spelling, use correct punctuation, and coherence in the story.

Requirements:

- Your comic book needs to contain at least 10 sentences that meet the following criteria.
- KEY: Your comic book MUST contain a "key" that identifies the grammar rule (and/or definition of the grammatical term) and the sentence from your book that meets that grammatical rule.
- You will work with a partner. You will be graded DAILY on your group participation and individual participation.
- You may create your comic book using online or digital media (websites, Power Point, or other technology that supports a comic book), but you can also create one by hand.
- The sentences, storyline, and images of your comic book MUST be appropriate.
