

# English 1 Independent Reading Assignment

Independent reading is an important part of our class. Each semester, you will be required to read one book outside of the assigned class reading. You will also be responsible for completing the entire Independent Reading Assignment Packet and turning it in by the appropriate deadline. You will be given time during class to work on this assignment, however you may also need to use time outside of the classroom as well. You are accountable for using class time wisely.

## EXPECTATIONS

- All students are required to read one grade-level appropriate book each semester.
- You will be able to choose your book, but it must be approved by the teacher.
- You must have a parent sign-off on your selection (on the **Independent Reading Introduction** page).
- Your selected piece of literature must be at least 100 pages in length.
- Bring your book to class each long-period.

## ASSIGNMENTS

- The **Independent Reading Introduction** page must be completed prior to beginning your book.
- The **Independent Reading Menu** and **End of Book Form** should be completed and turned in by the semester deadline.
