Surname (noun)

Definition: the name that a person has in common with other family members; family name.

Synonyms: last name, family name

Antonyms: nickname, first name

Sentence: Mrs. LaFlamme's **surname** does NOT rhyme with salami.

Fraught (adjective)

Definition: full of; filled; accompanied by.

Synonyms: filled, charged, abounding

Antonyms: empty

Sentence: Twitter is fraught with ridiculous hashtags that Mrs. LaFlamme can't stand.

Haste (noun)

Definition: swiftness of motion; speed

Synonyms: urgency, speed

Antonyms: slowness, delay, leisure

Sentence: Students should write down their vocabulary words with great haste so we don't run out of time during class.

Apparatus (noun)

Definition: any complex instrument or mechanism used for a particular purpose.

Synonyms: device, machine, mechanism

Antonyms:

Sentence: Mrs. LaFlamme needs some sort of apparatus that will toss starbursts to her students.

Delusion (noun)

Definition: a false belief or opinion

Synonyms: deception, fantasy

Antonyms: fact, reality, truth

Sentence: Mrs. LaFlamme has a paranoid delusion that students are always stealing her candy.

Anecdotes (noun)

Definition: a short account of a particular incident, especially of an amusing nature.

Synonyms: story, tale, incident

Antonyms:

Sentence: Mrs. LaFlamme loves to share personal anecdotes with her students.

Rouse (verb)

Definition: to bring out of a state of sleep; to stir up or incite someone to become angry

Synonyms: wake up, stir, get up

Antonyms: calm, deaden, lull, go to sleep

Sentence: Ms. Shaw likes to rouse sleeping students by spraying them with a water bottle.
